After all the dreariness of winter, aren't you wishing to see some lovely, living things? Maybe you'd like to add a houseplant to your home. There are lots of great plant varieties that are hearty and forgiving for those of us without a green thumb....

Christmas cactus - Epiphyllum

This little cactus is actually what I have on my desk here at Brookside Commons. The Christmas cactus doesn't have thorns and is extremely easy to take care of. The Christmas cactus usually only needs weekly watering and it will bloom annually and bring a little color to your space.

Jade Plant- Crassula ovata

With its unusual leaves and pink flowers, the jade plant is an eye catcher. Because it only requires a little bit of sunlight and doesn't need a lot of care, it's the perfect plant for those neglectful plant parents.

Spider Plant-Chlorophytum comosum

Originally from South Africa, the spider plant is one of the most common varieties of houseplant. The plant sends out long tendrils with white flowers that eventually grow into new little spider plants which can be transferred into a new pot. The spider plant love bright sunlight and can stand almost any temperature environment.

Any of these plants will brighten up your home and add a little color. Just a little love and attention and you should have a happy, healthy plant for many years to come!

Valentine's Day Chocolate Mousse

A Delicious Dessert that is sure to impress the one you Love!

Ingredients:

- 8 ounces semisweet chocolate
- 3 tablespoons powdered sugar
- 3 tablespoons strong brewed coffee or 3 tablespoons cocoa
- 2 -3 egg yolks
- 1 1/4 cups whipping cream



Directions:

1. Melt chocolate in a double boiler or in a pan with hot water.
2. Add sugar, coffee/cocoa, and egg yolks, one at a time. Stir until mixture has thickened. Remove from heat. Let cool.
3. Whip cream. Add to slightly cooled mixture.
4. Spoon mousse into individual serving dishes. Cover. Let cool in refrigerator 1 hour.
5. Garnish each serving with a spoonful of whipped cream.
